## Hilltop's Latimer House

Promoting Equity and Ending Violence: Latimer House's Mission and Approach

Hilltop's Latimer House Intimate Partner Violence and Sexual Assault Program is committed to promoting equity, inclusivity, and diversity to foster social change and end intimate partner violence and sexual assault in our community. We aim to address the societal inequities that contribute to and perpetuate these forms of violence. We support the self-determination of all individuals and provide leadership in advocacy efforts focused on both prevention and intervention. Our goal is to deliver a kind, compassionate, non-judgmental, client-driven service model that meets people where they are, empowers them, stabilizes them, and helps them build lives free from violence.

## Intimate Partner Violence and Sexual Assault Facts:

- In 2024, the Grand Junction Police Department reported 424 domestic violence cases, a 10.99% increase compared to 2023.
- Victims of abuse often report they return to an abusive situation because they cannot find affordable long-term housing.
- Victims of intimate partner violence lose a total of eight million days of paid work the equivalent of more than 32,000 full time jobs and nearly 5.6 million days of household productivity each year because of abuse.

## In 2024, Latimer House:

- Responded to over 1,400 crisis calls
- Supported 106 individuals through group sessions, case management, and advocacy
- Delivered 21 community presentations on intimate partner violence and sexual assault
- Provided safe shelter for 121 women, men and children
